The Interfraternity Congress (IFC) and Panhellenic Council (PHC), as a campus recipient of a portion of the Student Activities Fund, strives to support campus events and endeavors. The Executive Board of IFC and PHC will use the following criteria to evaluate the amount of funding disbursed to events requesting sponsorship. Events receiving funds do not necessarily have to fulfill all of the criteria, but they are listed in order of importance.

1. Greek Men and Women can benefit from this program/event through either personal, leadership, scholastic or organizational development.
2. Members of the campus community can benefit from this program/event through either personal, leadership, scholastic or organizational development.
3. The program/event has been organized to raise money for a philanthropic cause or providing a service to a respected philanthropic organization.
4. Greeks will have the opportunity to socialize with other members of the campus community.
5. Greeks have had an active part in planning or coordinating of the program/event.

All programs sponsored by the Interfraternity Congress & Panhellenic Council must be conducted in an atmosphere of mutual respect. No funds allocated by the Interfraternity Congress & Panhellenic Council may be used for the purchase of alcoholic beverages.
