Academic Pursuit of Greeks Pay Off for Community

As students flock back to campus after a well-deserved summer break, many students catch up on their work experiences, their friends, their families, and their lives. However, there has been a buzz amongst the community about the recent academic performance of Greeks on Case's campus. For the first time since the Fall of 1990, both the all fraternity and all sorority average G.P.A has surpassed the all men and all women average G.P.A , respectively. Last spring, the all fraternity G.P.A average was a 3.26 while the all sorority average was a staggering 3.38 G.P.A. In addition, within the past year, a number of chapters have received awards from the national groups recognizing their academic achievements, and at least three chapters on this campus achieved the highest GPA for any chapter in their organization.

Overall, the Greek community has displayed academic success that the entire community can share in. Over seventy percent of Greek members achieved a grade point average of 3.0 or better, while a astounding seventeen percent achieved a 4.0 grade point average. The academic success enjoyed by the community is directly tied to both the efforts of the scholarship chairs and the individual members. Congratulations to all the chapters and their members for their pursuit of knowledge and academic success. As we move forward into this new school year, let us carry this success as a motivator to push ourselves to even greater heights.
